

## Scoped Rifle Shoot 1 March 2020 Course of Fire

This Shoot is still experimental so be prepared for changes on the day.

1. As we have a number of butt changes then shooters should be prepared to get off the point quickly and to do their turn in the butts, more than once.
2. Sighters will be limited and so it is recommended that you shoot with a pal to act as a spotter.
3. We will be moving ranges so please keep your kit to a minimum to save time. Rifle, Ammunition and Optics only to save time. If you are in the butts and we change ranges then we don't want to carry a load of unnecessary Gear, 50 rounds plus Sighters
4. Targets will be PL 7 Fig 14, Fig 12 Fig 11 only for the competition.

### **Practice 1 300 yards**

Targets to be a Fig 14 and a Fig 12 side by side on the Manual Targets boards fixed at the front of the mantlet.

2 sighters on a handheld Fig 12

15 rounds fired in 3 minutes on command of the range officer

10 Rounds at the PL7

5 Rounds at the Figure 14

At the end of the practice the shooters will remove their rifles from the firing point immediately so the butt crew can mark the targets. (Shooters can return to the point to pick up their kit and empties once their rifles are off the point)

### **Practice 2 300 yards**

15 Rounds required.

10 x 3 second exposures of Fig 12 Target 1 round per exposure.

5 x 3 second exposure on a Fig 14 Target 1 round per exposure.

### **Practice 3 500 yards**

1 Sighter on a handheld fig 11 Target.

10 Rounds required

1 x 30 second exposures of Fig 11 Target 5 round per exposure.

1 x 30 second exposures of Fig 12 Target 5 round per exposure.

### **Practice 5 600 yards (Time Permitting)**

10 Rounds required

Electronic Target

11 shots in 90 seconds first shot non scoring (i.e. a sighter)
