

Dorking Rifle Club Re-opening Shoot Strategy

I need to firstly make it clear to all of you that the pandemic is still very much with us and the risks associated with this remain.

We are undertaking a limited experimental reopening of the club and will review outcome as we go along.

1. If you don't feel comfortable – don't come.
2. If you aren't well – don't come.
3. Shooting will be restricted to a pre-booked slot that can't be amended and if you miss it then that's it.
4. Shoots will be at a single distance pre advised and will be on electronic targets for a single 20 minute slot with a 5 minute change over. This will be strictly enforced.
5. Shooting will take place on the designated days as per the program.
6. We will only have three targets in operation (at the moment) and one shooter per target at one time only.
7. We will open the booking at the start of the week prior to the shoot and prospective attendance must email the club email address (dorkingr@gmail.com) requesting a slot.
8. This will be allocated on a first come first served.
9. The option will close on Friday and the list published on the web on Saturday before the shoot.
10. You should only arrive at the range no more than 15 minutes before your slot and leave directly after your shooting slot. No hanging about in the car park.
11. We will insist you leave so we can avoid any gathering rules / restrictions.
12. Shooters are encouraged to wear gloves and masks / homemade face covering whilst on the range.
13. No stands or mats provided (bring your own or it's on the grass).
14. When shooting is finished leave your gun on the FP, retire, RO to clear then it can be removed.
15. 20 minute slot 5 minute change over (turn up shoot and clear off)
16. No touching the monitors by shooters. These will be cleared by the RO wearing gloves.
17. The mule will be for transport of gear only. We can't take people and it can only be driven by someone wearing gloves. We will not add or remove items to the mule but we can make multiple trips up the range.
18. Maintain social distance at all times.
19. The clubhouse will be closed
20. Shooting records can be signed if they are left somewhere and the user retires while the RO signs it. The shooting Record book cannot be touched by anyone not wearing gloves.
